period	Courses are taught from February to the end of May.
	This period corresponds to the second semester of Year 1 of the International Relations program.
	We recommend international students arrive in Paris at least one week prior to the beginning of their

	Upon their arrival, international students are invited to IRIS Sup' International Office to register

	Second year: June-August
	Internship mobility.
Academic	IRIS Sup' academic rating coefficient calculus system is based on the European Standard (i.e.: 1 ECTS
